GR 5.1 u

The driver of a vehicle shall yield the right of way to a pedestrian or golf cart crossing the roadway within the marked road crossings, located at the Main Gate and Vacation Park. No pedestrian may suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or run into the path of a vehicle that is so close as to constitute an immediate hazard.

Fine: 1st \$250, 2nd 500, 3rd 750

Eddie made a motion to approve the new rule, Craig 2nd the motion. Allin favor to approve the rule as written.
