Celebrates 50th Anniversary

1971 – 2021



On October 6, 1971 the **Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club** filed "Articles of Incorporation" and "By-Laws" with the State of California and the rest is history. Throughout 2021 the Club will be celebrating its 50th Anniversary during tournaments and other activities, beginning with the Spring Kickoff Tournament on March 13 & 14.

There were 85 original Founding Members in 1971 and two of them, Gene Brown and Jim Lippen are still members of the Club 50 years later. They will be recognized at the beginning of the Spring Kickoff Tournament. Member Dave Shankland's father Jerry was also a founding member. The Club's ties to the past are strong. In 1971, the Club also applied for membership in the SCGA. Ralph Brogdon was the first President and he was supported by a ten-member Board of Directors. The Golf Professional was Phil Edmondson and Larvin Houston was Golf Course Superintendent. Weekday green fees for property owners were \$1.50 and guests and the public, \$3.00. Weekends it was \$3.00 and \$5.00 respectively and cart rentals at both times were \$7.00

Eight Men's Golf Club tournaments were held in 1971, the first being the "Valentine's Day Tournament" with 96 players. Now called the "Sweetheart Tournament", it continues on and this past month had 88 players. That first tournament had men's and women's flights, paying low gross and low net prizes in each flight. Two players also received a sleeve of golf balls for breaking 100 for the first time. Somewhere in the past 50 years it transitioned to a "couples" tournament.

In April 1971, the first Member/Guest tournament was held with 58 players, paying low gross and low net prizes to individuals and two-man teams. You could win in both categories. In May, a men's and women's "Breakfast Tournament" was held to inform the membership how to properly post scores (we could probably use one of those today). June and October featured Pro-Am tournaments, with June's being a "best ball" format of three-man teams and October's format was a foursome event with "two best balls of amateurs plus the Pro's ball". Over 30 teams participated in both events.

As true Canyon Lake golfers, believing in any excuse for a celebration, the "Wing-Ding on the Plumbout" tournament, celebrated a new extension to the clubhouse, known as the "Plumbout Room." It attracted 99 players and 140 for dinner. The last two tournaments of the year were a two-day eclectic sponsored by the golf professional for both men and women and the Presidents Cup, a low net/three flights tournament.

A lot happened that first year and a strong foundation was established that continues on today. Throughout the year articles will appear featuring the Clubs activities over the past 50 years.

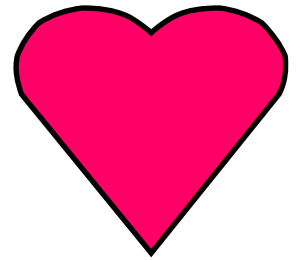

Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.287

Improvement factor: 1.287
