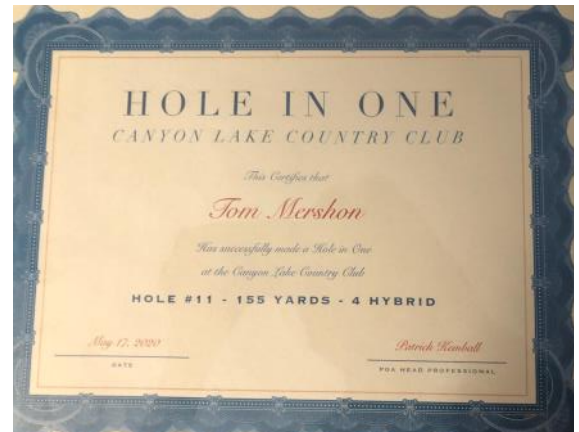

The World Handicap System is based on the premise that every player always plays the best shot possible for a positive outcome through the round. In other words, the player doesn't attempt shots with clubs that are in the bag that he doesn't expect will provide the best score (for ex. Using a driver and cutting a corner where the odds are against him for success). Or maybe it is playing around with the spouse or friends where the individual doesn't care that they shoot a good score.

Everyone is allowed a practice round once in a while, and after the round you do not post your round. Always declare your intentions to the pro shop prior to your round.

Golf is about integrity and honor. A virtue that I know we all strive to attain.


