A MESSAGE FROM YOUR CLUB HISTORIAN

Meet Your New President!

John Reed is the 53rd President of the Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club (CLMGC) and the second in a row to arrive in California from Arizona, albeit John did so when he was three years old and generally considers himself a native Californian. John has been married to Stephanie for 46 years and they have two daughters and six grandchildren, five girls and finally a boy, who was named Reed after his grandfather. One daughter and four grandchildren live in New Mexico and the other in Temecula with two grandchildren. John and Stephanie live in Murrieta and he is the first non-resident member of the CLMGC to be elected president.

John joined the CLMGC in 2018 after being a member of Canyon Crest Country Club (CCCC) in Riverside for over 20 years, where he served on the Men's Golf Association board for four years and as Handicap Chair. He also played on Thursday and Saturday team play at CCCC and that is where he first learned of Canyon Lake Golf & Country Club. After moving to Murrieta, it became convenient for him to join a course closer to home and Canyon Lake was his choice. John has been very active since joining the CLMGC, serving on the board these past two years in a combination of assignments as Membership, Rules and Handicap Chairman. He has also been an active participant in team play.

Growing up in California John played basketball and ran track in high school. He says he stopped playing sports in his senior year in order to go to work. While working he played fast pitch softball until he was 30 and then moved to "slow" pitch until 50. Throughout this time, he played golf and for the last 25 years he has averaged playing 3-5 times per week.

John's worked in the fast food and restaurant industry for 33 years. He spent ten years as a manager and store supervisor for McDonalds and retired from Polly's Pies as an Area Manager after 23 years. John spent a lot of hours working in the evening, hence his ability to play golf 3-5 time per week.

Golf in general plays a big role in John's life. He annually travels to Alabama to play courses on the "Robert Trent Jones Trail", as well as to Puerto Vallarta and Las Vegas. But John doesn't need to travel to play golf. He and his golf partner, Mike Sanders, many times play 15 or more days in a row and on one occasion played 33 days in a row. That's more than many of us play in a year.

Golf is not the only thing that plays a big part in John's life. A devout Christian, John was baptized in the Jordan River on a trip to Israel with his mother. At his church, he has served as a high school and college Sunday School teacher, filled in as the Youth Pastor and occasionally preached on Sunday.

One of the reasons Stephanie and John moved to Murrieta was to be closer to his daughter and two grandchildren in Temecula. When not on the golf course, John helps pickup the kids from school and is involved in their sports and other activities. And speaking of family, he has two nephews who are involved in professional baseball as coaches for the Arizona Diamondbacks and the Angels. He watches as many of their games as possible.

There's no doubt that John is a busy and involved guy, and now he's going to add being President of the CLMGC to his "to do" list. Based on his past successes, there's no doubt that the Men's Golf Club will have an experienced leader as their President in the coming year.

Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128

Improvement factor: 1.128
