Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example

Starting Handicap Index:  $24.3 \mid$  Ending Handicap Index:  $16.2 \mid$  Value A:  $24.3 + 12 = 36.3 \mid$  Value B:  $16.2 + 12 = 28.2 \mid$ 

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128 Improvement factor: 1.128

# Merry Christmas!

### December - 30 years ago - 1993!

In December 1993, the golf course was just reopening to carts on the fairways after the October overseeding. In those days, the course was closed to golf carts for 60 days after the overseeding. Now days, we start complaining about cart "paths only" after 14 days.

On December 1, Dave Lindeman became the Head Golf Pro, replacing Gabe Hrab, who had been the Pro for 14 years.

The Men's Golf Club was reminding members that they had until December 30 to pay their annual dues or they would be dropped from the SCGA and the Club. The dues were "\$70", including the SCGA membership. With our dues now at \$100, an average increase of \$1 per year doesn't seem so bad. Dinner at the Lodge after the Christmas Tournament was \$20 per person in 1993. This year's price has yet to be determined, but inflation over the past 30 years has been 108%.

Some of the winners of Wednesday golf and the "After Lunch Bunch" in December 1993 are still hanging in there and winning today, like Bob Stinson, Tom Fuhrman, Phil Coughlin and Hugh Wagoner. They're the CLMGC version of the "Die Hard Bunny", they just keep going and going and going and going and going.....

In 1993, and a few years before and after, the annual "Beautification Tournament" was put on by the Green Committee to promote tree planting and other landscaping on the golf course. Wonder if the Green Committee would like to return to the "years of yore"?

#### Mecember — 20 years ago - 2003!

Jump ahead ten years and the Men's Golf Club is still reminding members to get their "\$70" dues paid by December. Wow, ten years and no dues increase.

By now, the "Beautification Tournament" was under the auspices of the Canyon Lake Association of Past Presidents (CLAPPS) and 2002 CLMGC President Carlos Ramirez was Chair of the tournament. The tournament had 106 players and raised \$2,952. Jump ahead 20 years to 2023 and the CLAPPS are still staging this tournament, the **next one on April 27, 2024.** 

Jim Musser, Fred Hemborg, George Douglas, Marcus Schonabaum and Ed Doidge were winners of Wednesday and "After Lunch Bunch" games in December 2003. You can add them to the "Die Hard Bunny" club as they are still playing in 2023 and keep going and going and going....

The President of the Women's golf club was Zelda Dunn and the CLWGC had 206 members. Terry Miles was President of the CLMGC with a little over 400 members.




Aggressive Tire (cart path only)
