The year is half over! A look at the same period 20, 30 and 40 years ago! By Travis Montgomery

1984 – 40 years ago~ Ronald Reagan was President of the United States. Joe Hill was President of the Canyon Lake Men’s Golf Club and Jessie Gutierrez was President of the Women’s Golf Club. Most of us remember Ronald Reagan, but I don’t know about Joe and Jessie. John McCaffery won the first of his four Club Championships. At the June Board meeting of the Men’s Golf Club it was decided that the “monthly Men’s Golf Club Board Meetings” would be held on the first Wednesday of the month, instead of the first Saturday. There were now enough members, and Board members, living fulltime in Canyon Lake to warrant the change to Wednesday. This date is still in place, 40 years late. It was reported that the ice machine is broken beyond repair and a new one needed to be purchased. The Board voted to purchase a new ice machine for \$1,600. Hemet Federal Savings & Loan Association (a predecessor to PNC) became the “Sponsor” of the annual Tree Tournament (Beautification Tournament) as a way of showing their support of the growing Canyon Lake community, stated Carol Carter, Branch Manager.

1994 – 30 years ago~ Bill Clinton was President of the United States and Bill Novak was President of the Men’s Golf Club and Jackie Taylor, President of the Women’s Golf Club. I remember Bill Clinton and Jackie Taylor. This was the year and month that Marcus Schonabaum won his first Club Championship. The lake project on today’s hole #13 was completed after two years. The Men’s Golf Club contributed \$6,000 to the project. The Junior Golf Clinic sponsored by the Pro Shop was in progress as it is 30 years later. It appears this is a “keeper” event. Every other Friday night “Horse Races” were under way, as they are now. The bulletin read “those playing witnessed almost every bad shot in golf, (slices, hooks, sculls, shanks, etc.”). Some things never change. Thanks to Barbara and Larry Mensch for keeping this tradition going in 2024. Contact them if you want to play.

2004-20 years ago~ George W. Bush was President of the United States and Mike Cannavino was President of the Men’s Golf Club and Lorrie Cobb was President of the Women’s Golf Club. Now we are starting to see some names that we knew or can remember. Ian Nelson, who grew up playing Junior Golf in Canyon Lake, won his second straight Club Championship now that he was old enough to join the Men’s Golf Club. The TWG completed the “rebuilding” of the tee boxes on holes # 8 and 9. Pretty much the way they are today. Fred Hemborg, Membership Director reported that the Men’s Golf Club had 472 members. If you arrive early at the golf course, you can still see Fred playing daily at the “break of dawn”. Alice Ramirez was the Women’s Golf Club Membership Chairman and she reported they had 195 members and five social members.

Marcus Schonabaum wins 8th Club Championship ~

In April, Marcus Schonabaum won his 8th Club Championship over a span of 30 years. At age 38, Marcus won his first Canyon Lake Men’s Golf Club Championship in 1994. At age 67, he won his 8th Club Championship. He’s kind of like the “Die Hard Bunny”, he just keeps winning and winning and winning!

Marcus’s 8th win, puts him third on the list of all-time Club Championship winners. Leading the way is **Brandon Mojarro** with 10 wins. He pretty much dominated the Championship during the period 2010 – 2019 with nine of his wins coming during that time. His first win was in 2010 at age 34 and his last in 2021 at age 45. It appears that he still has a few years to go to add to his list of Championships. Sandwiched between Bandon and Marcus with nine Club Championships in **Bert Nafziger**. Bert won the second Club Championship in 1973 and over the course of the next 10 years, he won his nine Championships. Bert passed away in the early 2000’s.

Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: $24.3 + 12 = 36.3$ | Value B: $16.2 + 12 = 28.2$

A / B: $36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128$

Improvement factor: 1.128
