Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

Example:

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: $24.3 + 12 = 36.3$ | Value B: $16.2 + 12 = 28.2$

A / B: $36.3 / 28.2 = 1.128$

Improvement factor: 1.128

Happenings in the Past from your CLMGC Historian:

40 years ago, June 1984 ~

June was Men's Golf Club Championship month as it is this year. In 1984, it was a four-day event, held over two weekends. John McCaffrey, father of current member Collin McCaffrey, would win the first of his four Club Championships, defeating Bert Nafziger, who had won nine ((9) of the previous eleven (11) Club Championships. John went on to win the Club Championship in 1986, 1989 and 1993. In 1984, there was a "pond" around then hole #11, today's hole #13. In June 1984 the golf course superintendent proudly announced that an "aerator" was being installed in the pond and the pond on hole #8 (just right of the green today) was being cleaned and refilled. The following article will discuss the conversion of the "pond" on #11 to today's lake on #13. The superintendent also reported that they were running low on "reclaimed water" to water the golf course and that they were meeting with the EVMWD to solve the problem. (I would imagine the more houses you have, the more reclaimed water you will have, and Canyon Lake was still very undeveloped residentially in 1984).

30 years ago, June 1994 ~

June 1994 finally ended a project started two years previously by the Tuesday Work Group (TWG), the conversion of the pond on hole #11 (#13) to a lake. In early June the lake was completing filling with water and the TWG was more than ready to move onto other projects after their summer break. The Bulletin of June 1994 says that ... "the girls will be happy to have the course to themselves"... on Tuesdays. (That's probably still true), Again, June was Club Championship month, and Marcus Schonabaum won the first of his seven (7) Club Championships to date. He's like a "Die Hard Battery", he just keeps going and going and is still a strong competitor in the club championship. Hugh Wagoner (yes, the same Hugh Wagoner we see on the golf course today) was the Team Play Captain and was starting preparations for the 1995 team play season (another Die Hard Battery). And speaking of "Die Hards", Joanna Spiller was a member of the Women's Golf Club Board and placed third in the Club Championship in her flight. She too is still seen on the golf course.

20 years ago, June 2004 ~

Now we're getting into a time frame that many of us can still remember. Mike Cannavino was the Men's Golf Club president and presided over a membership of 470. Lorrie Cobb was the Women's Golf Club president, presiding over a membership of 198, and Jeannette Williams won the second of her three (3) Women's Golf Club Championships. And again, it was Club Championship time for the men. Ian Nelson, age 21, won his second Club Championship in a row and would go on to become a professional golfer and assistant golf pro at Canyon Lake Country Club. Marcus Schonabaum qualified for the California Golf Association State Championship at Pebble Beach. Marcus qualified by tying for low gross, with a 69, on the River Course at The Alisal. And speaking again of "Die Hards", Handicap Director Dudley Thompson expressed concern about members turning in score cards with only "first names". (Seems like I've heard that complaint before).

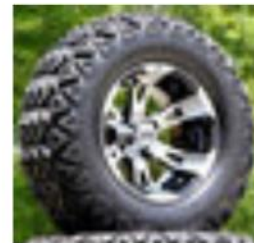
Normal Golf Tire
