# HOLE SEQUENCE

Why are we changing the order in which we play the holes?

Better Pace of play:

- #12 fairway is wide compared to #1 fairway, so less chance for golfers to get in trouble. There is also no cart path access to the Club House on hole #12. Golfers do not have to wait to tee off while waiting for cart traffic.
- Playing the course with hole #12 as the first hole would mean there is not a Par 3 until fourth hole creating less of a back up so early in the round.
- Typically there is a 10+ minute time between hole #9 and hole#10. This would be eliminated because the round will end after the current hole #9. (#9 would be #18).

Congestion around the Clubhouse:

- Currently there is a lot of cart congestion around teeing areas of #12, #10, #1, and #18. Carts are crisscrossing from #9 to #10, and from #11 to #12. Carts are also leaving the #12 tee and carts are heading to the Clubhouse from #18 green. Carts are also coming to and from the community and Clubhouse.
- With the new hole order, cart traffic will flow better around the Clubhouse.
- #18 green is where players park and hang out causing a lot of congestion. This will no longer happen because it will be hole #7.

#9 as a finishing hole:

- Hole #9 is a tough Par 4 and would make a good finishing hole
- It is close to the driving range covered patio which would make a good area for scoring, socializing, and possible banquet area. There is cart parking there.

Food/Beverage Ordering:

- Players can place a food/beverage order at the new hole #8 (near clubhouse) and pick it up after playing hole #8 and #9 (26 minute playing time) on their way to new hole #10.

Pro Shop Operations:

- The Pro Shop will have a clear view of the holes #1 and #10 which will improve their ability to control player flow.

## From your Historian ~

**54 years ago – September 1970:** The first *Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club Bulletin* was published, **Vol. 1, No. 1**. Its headline read: **"It's a Reality! Golf Club Starts!"** The first article touted a "Get Acquainted Tourney" hosted by the Men's Golf Club, the POA and the Corona Land Company. The bulletin also promoted membership in the CANYON LAKE MEN'S GOLF CLUB that was being established. The cost of membership was \$10, including the \$6 fee to the SCGA. Those joining by October 31 would be "Charter Members". (The Men's Golf Club dues are \$100 and the SCGA dues are \$41 as of January 1, 2025). An "Interim Board of Directors" was announced for the Men's Golf Club that would work to formalize the incorporation of the Canyon Lake Men's Golf Club. (The Club was fully incorporated in March 1971). The Bulletin also announced that two months previous, in July, the long-awaited opening of the back nine holes occurred, making the course a full 18 holes. The Women's Golf Club was also being organized and held their first meeting in September. ***For our members under 54 years of age, a lot has happened at Canyon Lake Golf and Country Club since you were born, AND, a lot remains the same.***

**40 years ago – September 1984:** Here's what the opening of the President's message had to say: *"It's time again to start setting up your foursomes for Golf Cart Stag Day"*. (40 years ago, they gave away a golf cart instead of \$5,000)." The Stag Day tournament flyer said there would be two shotgun starting times, 7:00 a.m. and 12 noon, with a handicap flight and a Calloway flight. The field would be limited to 248 players. The cost of the tournament and dinner and a drawing ticket is \$50. 350 tickets will be sold, with winners every tenth ticket drawn, with the last ticket drawn winning the golf cart. Tickets for the drawing only are \$25 and **"Women may purchase tickets for the drawing, but will not be able to attend the Barbeque Dinner"**. I guess that's what **"Stag Day"** means.

The president also announced that "construction will start very soon on the permanent restrooms on holes #6 and #16. The Men's and Women's golf club have approved an expenditure of \$10,000 from the building fund to finance approximately one-half of the cost". There was no Country Club building at the time, and the Stag Day barbeque and social events were held at the Lodge. Permanent restrooms, (the ones we use today), were built before a Club House! The Men's and Women's Golf Clubs contributed approximately \$200,000 towards the cost of the eventual club house.

**30 years ago – September 1994:** Stag Day was again the main theme of the President's bulletin message and a golf cart was the main drawing prize. The Board minutes reflect that it was approved by the Board to pay three places in each net flight and three places in the gross flight for the Stag Day tournament. And as happens most every September, the Board was looking for candidates to run for the Board. The CLAPPS hosted the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Charity Golf Tournament. Proceeds from the tournament were donated to needy families in the area, selected by local churches. The **Great American Golf Shop** on Railroad Canyon Rd. was under new ownership. The new owners, Bob and Marina Stinson were the Exclusive Distributor of Club Car golf cars for South Riverside County. Bob's still around, Marina's still around, but no more Great American Golf Shop. Speaking of still around, the **After Lunch Bunch** was running strong and the bulletin shows that **current** After Lunch Bunch member **Hugh Wagoner** and his partners were weekly winners. Hugh's like the "Die Hard Bunny", he just keeps going, and going and going.

Here's to a great Stag Day 2024!

**Instructions for determining the Most Improved Golfer**

Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the start date. This value is A. Add 12 to the player's Handicap Index at the end date. This value is B.

Divide value A by value B, calculating to three decimal places. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor should receive the most improved player award.

**Example:**

Starting Handicap Index: 24.3 | Ending Handicap Index: 16.2

Value A: 24.3 + 12 = 36.3 | Value B: 16.2 + 12 = 28.2

A / B: 36.3 / 28.2 = 1.288

Improvement factor: 1.128
